Dear Murphy First,

What a beautiful Advent season! Thank you for how generous you were with your time, giving, singing, and your spirit of joy.

As I write, it is the 4th day of Christmas. Christmas is its own season, like Advent, and lasts 12 days, so keep on singing those Christmas carols.

On Sunday (12/31) in worship, there will be a service of "covenant renewal." This has been a traditional New Year's Eve service for United Methodists for centuries. It is a time to recommit ourselves to Christ at the start of the new year. Here is an excerpt from that service (the full insert is included in the newsletter):

Leader: Let us gathered here before the Lord now in covenant commit ourselves to Christ as his servants. Let us give ourselves to Him so that we may fully belong to Him. Jesus Christ has left us with many services to be done. Some of these services are easy and honorable, but some are difficult and disgraceful. Some line up with our desires and interests, others are contrary to both. In some we please both Christ and ourselves, but then there are other works where we cannot please Christ except by denying ourselves. Jesus Christ, we offer You this prayer:

People: Let me be Your servant. Let me follow your commands. I will no longer follow my own desires. I give myself completely to your will.

There are some big prayers we pray, and big commitments we make in this service—never made lightly. I hope at the start of this new year, if you aren't able to be in worship 12/31, that you'll take time to consider how you will seek first God's kingdom in 2024.

Are there ministries you will recommit yourself to in 2024? If you're still looking for a way to get involved, will you commit to trying something new before the end of January—maybe serving at Soul Table, helping with childcare, volunteering in the office, helping lead worship? Or maybe you'll join a Sunday school class, or start a new group?

In thinking about this Covenant Renewal service, I remember how one of our 5 Core Values as a church is Faithfulness. That's something this congregation identified together—that it is important to us that we are faithful to God and to the church.

Community takes commitment. For the church to be a community, we show up not just for ourselves but for one another. We get to know each other—who can you meet for coffee or a walk to get to know better? We think of the interests and needs of others. Our commitment (our Faithfulness) isn't to programs; it is to people...to Relationships (another of our Core Values).

Lots to celebrate about what God is doing in the life of Murphy FUMC, and I'm looking forward to continuing to grow with you in 2024!







People: Let me be Your servant. Let me follow your commands. I will no longer follow my own desires. I give myself completely to your will.

Leader: The power and strength to live as true servants is given to us in Christ. We accept the place and work that He gives us, acknowledging that He alone will be our reward.

People: I am not my own. I am Yours alone. Make me into what You will. Rank me with those You will. Put me to use for You. Put me to suffering for You. Let me be employed for You. Let me be laid aside for You. Let me be lifted high for You. Let me be brought low for You. Let me be full or let me be empty. Let me have all things or let me have nothing. With a willing heart, I freely give everything to Your pleasure and disposal.

Leader: Christ is Savior to those who are His true servants. He is the source of all salvation to those who obey. To be His servant is to consent fully to His will. Christ accepts nothing less. Christ will be all in all, or He will be nothing.

During the offering, I invite you now to take a minute for reflection of how you might make this covenant a reality in your life--through commitments of prayer, study, self-reflection, service, or other ways of turning to God. How might you rely on God's grace and strength, and trust in God's promises? Identify 1 or 2 friends with whom you will share your intentions.

Prayer: Almighty God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, you have now become my Covenant Friend. And I, through Your infinite grace, have become Your covenant servant. You are mine and I am Yours. So be it. May this covenant that I have made here on earth be ratified in heaven. Amen.




